## C of C Honors Two

The Chamber of Commerce of Bethel Park on Saturday night, September 26, cited two local men for their contributions to the community.

The Borough's jogging Director of Recreation, Charles E. Kuhn was named "Man of the Year" by the local group, in recognition of his efforts to provide opportunities for recreation and physical fitness for Borough residents from the very young on through the golden-agers. This special recognition was also given to Dr. David C. McNary, for his civic contributions over many years.

"Doc" who is President of Pittsburgh Western Land Corp., which developed Bethel Park's Industrial Boulevard Complex, is currently President of the National Association of Industrial Parks and "Doc" McNary, the veterinarian in Castle Shannon for 25 years. These are two men who have done much to make this community "a good place to live and do business" -- the motto of the Bethel Park Chamber of Commerce. Mr.

Kuhn is Chairman of the Health and Physical Education Department of the Bethel Park Elementary Schools and is serving as Chairman of Recreation for the Pennsylvania State Association for Health, Physical Education and Recreation.

Mr. Kuhn, who came to Bethel Park in 1960, has his B.S. and M. Ed. from the University of Pittsburgh and has been a physical education and health teacher for over 20 years, having served as Recreation Director for the Borough of Dormont for 15 years before resigning to come to Bethel Park.

He is consultant to Bethel Park's Commission for

Public Parks, Board member of the Bethel Park Civic Betterment Association and a recipient of Jaycee's "Man of the Year" award for his accomplishments in the field of physical fitness.

Dr. McNary, who worked his way through college to be a veterinarian, was the developer of the area now known as "Dogpatch".

He has been a member of the Chamber of Commerce since its inception and before that, on the old Bethel Board of Trade.

He was largely responsible for the elimination of the South Park Road underpass, and has been on the Bethel

Park Planning Commission for nine years.

Dr. McNary is also a Director of the Southwest Mental Health Center, President of the Bethel Park Police Awards Foundation, member of the Greater Pittsburgh Economic Development Council and the Western Pennsylvania Conservancy.

The awards were presented to Mr. Kuhn and Dr. McNary at the annual Dinner-Dance held by the Chamber of Commerce at St. Clair Country Club on Saturday, September 26. Chairman Harold Comell completed the arrangements.
